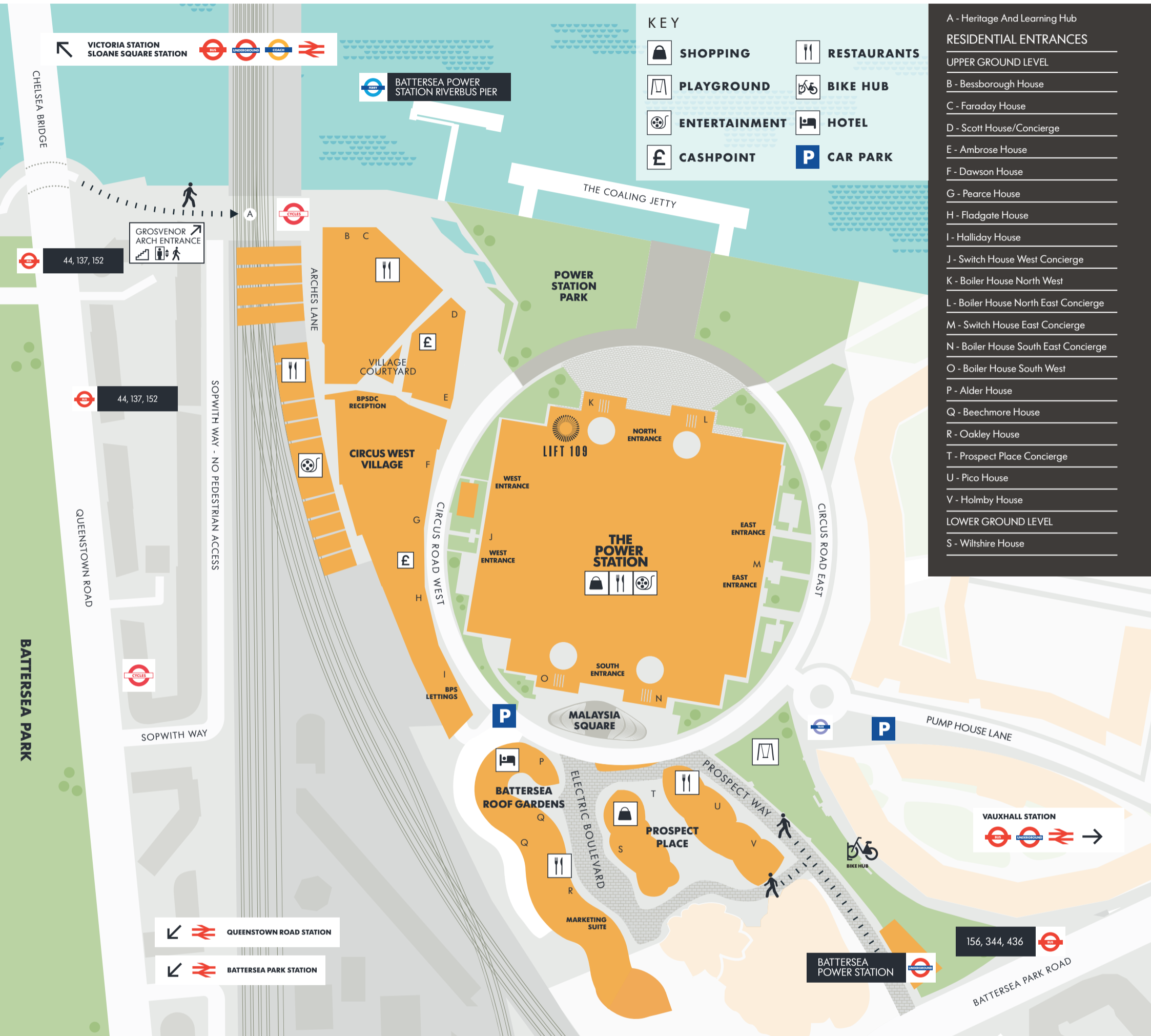


GETTING HERE

Battersea Power Station has numerous public transport connections and we are keen to keep our carbon footprint down, but if you have to come by car, we have parking available 24 hours a day in Circus West Village and Electric Boulevard.



BY TUBE / TRAIN / BUS:

Battersea Power Station

(Northern Line)

Sloane Square

(District & Circle Lines) 15 minute walk or a 5 minute bus ride (routes 452 or 137)

Battersea Park

(Trains) 10 minute walk

Queenstown Road

12 minute walk from the train station, 5 minute walk from Battersea Park Chelsea Gate bus stops (routes 44, 137 or 452)

UBER BOAT BY THAMES CLIPPERS:

The River Bus service operates from Battersea Power Station. The Battersea Power Station pier is open at Circus West Village and the River Bus service runs between 21 other piers from Putney to Woolwich. Hop on board and get to Embankment within 15 minutes, Blackfriars within 20 minutes and Canary Wharf within 40 minutes.

BY CAR:

Taxi drop off

Enter Pump House Lane from Battersea Park Road, drive to the end of the road and find the drop off area by the roundabout.

BY CAR (cont.):

Parking - Circus West Village Car Park

Enter Pump House Lane from Battersea Park Road, drive to the end of the road and turn left at the roundabout. Continue along Circus Road West for 200m, then turn left down the access ramp into the car park.

Parking - Electric Boulevard Car Park

Enter Pump House Lane from Battersea Park Road and continue for approx. 200m, access to the car park is signposted on the left-hand side.

Parking is available 24 hours a day.
